the third millennium.

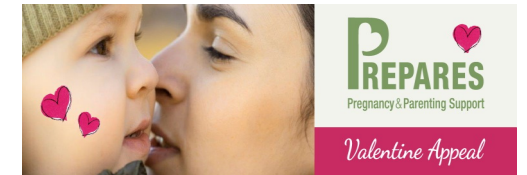

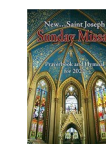
